Awards:	Cash prizes for 1 st & 2 nd place. 3 rd place, Honourable Mention and People's Choice recognition awards. Winners will be announced at the Opening reception and displayed on our website for the duration of the show.

That means the following: wiring must be professionally mounted on the work, artworks with no frames must have completed sides, frames must be suitable for show/sale.
